#### Message From National President Larry Cassell



#### LET'S START POKING

When reading the winter edition of the Ruritan Magazine, my message referred to five steps to build our organization. The third step was enhancing the pool of effective leaders at all levels in Ruritan.

While on my travels as well as checking the mms, i find that many of our leaders at all levels of Ruritan continue to be the same people repeating leadership positions over and over. Certainly experience and knowledge of the organization are key ingredients to success. However, are we stymieing others from stepping up? Others who may have great ideas and enthusiasm to make a difference.

Current leaders in Ruritan should be constantly seeking out individuals who could take on additional responsibilities that will grow Ruritan. Give them a **poke**. A young lad noted that at weddings sometimes elderly people next to him would poke him and say, "you are next!" So the young lad started to do the same to the elderly people at funerals. Well, it is everyone's responsibility to poke those individuals in our clubs, districts, and on national level who would make a difference by having a leadership role in growing our organization.

A quote from Eleanor Roosevelt alludes to the need for everyone to take risks, which some consider taking on a leadership postion.

As something to be fearful:

You gain strength, courage, and confidence by every Experience in which you really stop to look fear in the face.

You must do the thing which you think you cannot do.

If you are a Ruritan, guess what? You are already a leader; a leader within your community. Why not take the risk and consider one of the following:

- Club level: chair a committee, serve as a board of director, or be an executive officer
- District level: chair a committee or serve as a cabinet member
- National level: start as a national director and then consider another executive office

Ruritan National provides several resources regarding various leadership positions. Go on the mms and go through the various officer traning modules. This will give you some insight as to the duties of the various officers at the club and district level. Obtain a copy of the Ruritan Club and Disrict Officers **Handbook**, which has a lot of information of the workings of our organization and duties of the various officers. Other resources you can obtain from national are Handbook for National Officers, Directors, and Committees as well as Guidelines for Candidates. Better yet, talk with current and past leaders. You will find that everyone who has held an office has found it to be rewarding.

Do not sit back and leave it up to others. Take that risk. Get involved. You will find it to be worth your time and effort. Ruritan needs you now more than ever. Step up to make a difference.
